

A Bill to Include Veterans with PTSD for Purple Heart Eligibility

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 Article 1. The United States Federal Government will adjust the eligibility
3 requirements to receive the Purple Heart award to include veterans who
4 suffer from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder.

5 Article 2. Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) is a condition of persistent
6 mental and emotional stress occurring as a result of injury or severe
7 psychological shock.

8 Article 3. This legislation will go into effect immediately after passage.

9 Article 4. The United State Department of Veteran Affairs will oversee
10 enforcement of this bill alongside the Executive Branch and Department
11 of Defense.

12 Article 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
13 void.

A Bill to Combat Famine in Africa

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 Article 1. The United States dedicate \$500,000,000 towards humanitarian
3 assistance in South Sudan, Somalia, and Nigeria annually over the next
4 10 years. The United States shall also deploy ground troops in order to
5 protect this aid.

6 Article 2. Humanitarian aid shall be defined as food, water, and infrastructure.

7 Article 3. This legislation shall go into effect on October 1st, 2018.

8 Article 4. The Department of Defense, along with USAID shall be responsible for
9 implementation of this legislation.

10 A. The United States shall deploy a total 10,000 ground troops to
11 protect this aid in South Sudan, Somalia, and Nigeria.

12 B. Any troops deployed shall be used for the sole purpose of
13 delivering humanitarian aid, and/or protecting the aids' delivery.

14 Article 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
15 void.

A Bill to Limit the United States’ Nuclear Arsenal

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 Article 1. The construction of new nuclear processing facilities will be canceled.

3 The development of new ICBMs will be canceled and the current ICBM
4 fleet will be reduced by 50% by 2022.

5 Article 2. “Nuclear processing facilities” are defined as any facility where
6 materials are processed to power nuclear weapons.

7 Article 3. This bill will be implemented immediately after passage.

8 Article 4. The Department of Defense is responsible for the implementation of this
9 legislation.

10 Article 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
11 void.

The Environmental Future Protection Act of 2018

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 Article 1 All oil and natural gas subsidies shall be phased out within the next
3 twenty years. A minimum of five percent of current subsidies shall be
4 phased out each year until the conclusion of the twenty-year period.

5 Article 2. Oil and natural gas subsidies shall be defined as government actions that
6 lower the cost of their production, lower the price paid by their consumers,
7 or increase the price received by their producers.

8 Article 3. This bill shall be enacted one year following passage.

9 Article 4. The Department of Energy shall oversee implementation and enforcement
10 of this legislation by adjusting its budget each year to account for gradual
11 changes.

12 Article 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
13 void.
