

**A Bill to Amend the Military Selective Service Act to Mandate the Registration of Women
with the Selective Service System**

1 Be it enacted by the congress here assembled that:

2 Article 1. The Military Selective Service Act shall be amended to mandate that
3 women ages 18-25, as well as men, must register with the Selective
4 Service System so they can be called upon in the case of a military draft.

5 Article 2. Any mention of only men in the text shall be changed to include all United
6 States citizens, regardless of gender.

7 Article 3. This bill shall be enacted immediately upon being signed into law by the
8 President of the United States of America, and all women between the ages
9 of 18-25 must register with the Selective Service System by January 1,
10 2020.

11 Article 4. The Department of Defense shall oversee the implementation of these
12 changes to the Military Selective Service Act, specifically in ensuring the
13 registration of women.

14 Article 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Withdraw from the World Bank

1 Be it enacted by the congress here assembled that:

2 Article 1. The United States shall no longer financially support the World Bank.

3 Article 2. All monetary appropriation supporting the World Bank, including – but
4 not limited to – direct payments, salaries of employees and staff, and
5 future commitments, shall be considered “financial support.”

6 Article 3. Support will continue through FY 2018; support will cease at the end of
7 said fiscal year.

8 Article 4. The U.S. Department of State shall oversee cessation of U.S. support
9 of the organization. The Department of State shall review other options
10 to encourage global development and will submit to Congress a
11 recommendation for the re-application of funds.

12 Article 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to End the Republic of Korea Alliance

1 Be it enacted by the congress here assembled that:

2 Article 1. The United States shall henceforth be at peace with the Democratic
3 People's Republic of Korea.

4 Article 2. The U.S. and South Korean alliance established in the U.S.-R.O.K.
5 Mutual Defense Treaty shall be concluded in 2020.

6 Article 3. This bill shall be enacted immediately upon being signed into law by the
7 President of the United States of America.

8 Article 4. The U.S. Department of Defense will oversee the enforcement of all
9 American troops leaving the Republic of Korea by December 31, 2020.

10 Article 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
