A Bill to Increase Funds to Improve the Effectiveness of the War on Terror

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT: Funding for the "War on Terror" will change focus to creation of 2 Section 1. 3 infrastructure within the Middle East. 4 Section 2. Infrastructure shall be defined as educational facilities, roads, electrical 5 grids, water supplies, and bridges. Section 3. The United States Army Corps of Engineers shall be responsible for the 6 7 planning and construction of all projects. 8 A. The Department of State shall approve all plans and locations. 9 B. The Department of State will approve educational curriculums. C. Funding shall be \$2.5 Billion dollars funded from Overseas 10 11 Contingency Operations (OCO). 12 Section 4. Implementation will begin no later than June 1, 2025. 13 Section 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

2	Section 1.	Private Detention Centers will no longer house undocumented immigrants			
3	Section 2.	Oversight of these undocumented immigrants will be returned to the U.S.			
4		Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency. Immigrants currently			
5		held in Private Detention Centers will be transported to I.C.E. regulated			
6		Detention Centers. \$100 million will be allocated to fund new detention			
7		facilities and cover new guard and equipment fees.			
8	Section 3.	The U.S. Department of Homeland Security and the US Immigration and			
9		Customs Enforcement Agency shall oversee the implementation and			
10		enforcement of this legislation.			
11	Section 4.	This legislation will take effect in the calendar year of 2025.			
12	Section 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

7			human or humans:			
8		B.	A vehicle refers to any means in or by which someone travels or			
9			something is carried or conveyed			
10		C.	An autonomous car is a vehicle that can guide itself without human			
11			conduction.			
12	Section 3:	The Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Federal				
13		Highw	vay Administration, will oversee the enforcement of this bill.			
14	Section 4:	This bill will be partially implemented by 2025 in order to allow for				
15		infrast	ructure development and fully implemented in all fifty states by			
16		2035.				
17	Section 5:	All oth	ner laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall hereby be			
18		declar	ed null and void.
