

The Amtrak Affordability Act

1 Be it enacted by the Palm Beach Catholic Forensic League Student Congress here
2 assembled:

3 Article I. For a coach ticket on any given route, Amtrak may charge no more
4 than 50% of the average airfare cost for a comparable itinerary. For
5 fare on a sleeper car (where available), Amtrak may charge no more
6 than an amount equal to the average airfare cost for a comparable
7 itinerary.

8 Article 2 Congress shall divert an additional \$1 billion annually to Amtrak to
9 subsidize ticket prices and to be used to make Amtrak more
10 affordable and efficient overall.

11 Article III This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of
12 Transportation, which shall be directed to work with Amtrak to design
13 an efficient and regularly updated system for determining and
14 guaranteeing appropriate fares.

15 Article IV This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2026.

16 Article V All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
17 void

A Bill to End Aid for Ukraine

1 Be it enacted by the Palm Beach Catholic Forensic League Student Congress here
2 assembled:

3 Article I. The United States shall halt the transfer of weapons, supplies, and
4 any other form of aid to Ukraine immediately and indefinitely.

5 Article II This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Defense.

6 Article III This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

7 Article IV All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
8 void.

A Bill to Limit Tourism in National Parks

1 Be it enacted by the Palm Beach Catholic Forensic League Student Congress here

2 assembled:

3 Article I. In order to better enable the National Park Service (NPS) to achieve its

4 mission, the number of visitors allowed in National Park Areas shall

5 be limited.

6 Article II. The NPS is instructed to evaluate an environmentally and logistically

7 sustainable capacity for each of its parks and park areas and to set

8 limits accordingly. The NPS shall have full discretion over the

9 parameters and details of these restrictions, but they are directed to

10 keep matters of equity and accessibility in mind when determining

11 which visitors gain access.

12 Article III This legislation shall be overseen by the NPS.

13 Article IV This legislation shall take effect on January 1, 2026.

14 Article V. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null

15. and void.
