

**A Bill to Repair Crumbling Roads and Bridges**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 Section 1. In order to help fix crumbling roads and bridges, \$200 billion will be set  
3 aside in order to repair them to a safer and more stable condition.

4 Section 2. Crumbling roads and bridges will be defined as any road or bridge deemed  
5 to be in poor or mediocre condition, or having deteriorating components.

6 Section 3. The Department of Transportation will oversee the implementation of this  
7 legislation.

8 a. 75% of the \$200 billion will be put in to the U.S. Highway Trust  
9 Fund to invest in repairing interstates and bridges run by the  
10 federal government.

11 b. The remaining 25% of the funds will be distributed to state  
12 transportation departments, which will fund repairs of bridges and  
13 roads owned and operated by the states.

14 c. The U.S. Gas Tax will be increased to 30 cents per one gallon of  
15 gas and the tax on Diesel will be increased to 40 cents per one  
16 gallon of diesel fuel.

17 Section 4. This legislation will take effect in the fiscal year (FY) 2021.

18 Section 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

**A Bill to Ban Military Aid to Saudi Arabia**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 Section 1. The United States will no longer give military aid to Saudi Arabia until the  
3 conflict in Yemen ends.

4 Section 2. Military aid is defined as tanks, planes, bombs, refueling planes, firearms,  
5 or any device used by the military.

6 Section 3. The Department of Defense will oversee the implementation of this  
7 legislation and make sure that no military aid is sold.

8 a. Any military aid deal with Saudi Arabia that is not yet complete  
9 will immediately be cancelled and the Department of State will end  
10 all negotiations.

11 b. The Department of Defense will cease all manufacturing of  
12 weapons or other military aid for Saudi Arabia and any military aid  
13 already manufactured will either be destroyed or incorporated into  
14 the U.S. Army.

15 Section 4. This legislation will take effect immediately after passage.

16 Section 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

**A Bill to Provide Asylum for Undocumented Immigrants**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 Section 1. This act allows un-documented people to be given a chance of redeeming  
3 citizenship legally, without any undo consequences.

4 Section 2. Un-documented migrants must follow distinctive rules, to legally receive  
5 citizenship.

6 a. Must register for special naturalization progress at USCIS  
7 facilities.

8 b. They will be given a visa stating that they are able, and legal to  
9 work, and MUST find an eligible, and sustainable career.

10 c. Must pay ALL forms and types of taxes as American citizens.

12 d. Committing any serious felony, and or being given more then 5  
13 illegal notices such as speeding tickets, will result in either  
14 immediate deportation, or criminal trials.

15 Section 3. The United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) shall  
16 oversee the effect of this bill

19 Section 4. This legislation shall go into effect within 60 days of passage.

20 Section 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
